






1-26 | BETWEEN I-20 AND ST. ANDREWS ROAD

I-20 | BETWEEN BUSH RIVER ROAD AND I-26







Utilities

- Utility Task Force to mitigate risk

- Considering: MOU's with major utilities





- Level B/C SUE 80% complete
- Tracking new utility installation via encroachment permits

## Geotechnical Investigations

- Baseline Geotechnical Report complete
- Over 200 soil borings and associated testing complete





Pavement

- Set up as an asphalt job
- Providing multiple pavement options
- Considering: ATCs for concrete pavement
- I-26/I-126 rehab includes replacement of asphalt in composite sections

- Expect areas of poor subgrade under existing shoulders and new location alignments
- Considering: Performance specification on temporary pavement





## **Naintenance** of Iraffic

- Considering: Alternative MOT design criteria for hourly lane closure restrictions
- Considering: Coordination with DB Teams on long-term lane closure





## INIR Interchange Design

- Two IMRs underway for entire project
- Expected approval prior to RFP release





## Design Submittal Reviews

- Segmentation within the project limits will be allowed
- Partial submittals will be entertained





ROW Acquisition

- Early and Post-ROD Acquisitions
- Remaining ROW Acquisition will be the responsibility of the Design Build Team
- Considering: Various options for ROW payment responsibility





## Environmental Mitigation/Permitting

- Permittee Responsible Mitigation (PRM) Plan will be provided by SCDOT
- PRM is anticipated to provide sufficient credits for Preferred Alternative





# Environmental Sustainability

- Currently being tracked and monitored
- Design-Build contractor may be required to document sustainability management








