## PREFACE

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) <u>Geotechnical Design Manual</u> (GDM) has been developed to provide uniform practices for SCDOT's designers to complement the Mission of SCDOT by providing for safe, economical, effective and efficient geotechnical designs.<sup>1</sup>

Office of Engineering Support – Geotechnical Design Section (OES/GDS) has decided starting with this version of the GDM to drop all version numbers and to refer to the year of issue; therefore, the 2022 GDM, supersedes all previous editions of the GDM and all publications relating to the geotechnical aspects of transportation projects.
